Vid slutet av året var antal aktiva doktorander 44 (21 män/23 kv). Antal utlysningstillfällen var 6 och totalt antal sökanden till FU var 104. Antal nyantagna doktorander var 16 (8 män/8 kv) av vilka 13 finansierades helt eller delvis av institutionen, 1 med externa medel och 2 finansierades med EU-anslag (Marie Curie).

Antal examina uttagna under året var 7 (3 män, 4 kv) doktors- och 1 licentiat (man)-examen.

1.4 Uppdragsutbildning

Institutionen gav under 2012 två kurser i Kriminalvård, 7,5 + 7,5 hp till KY-utbildningen i Västerås kommun inom en utbildning i "Socialt behandlingsarbete, inriktning Kognitiv beteendeterapi". Antalet deltagare var 26 på den första kursen och 31 på den andra.

Inom ramen för Psykoterapeututbildningen har institutionen ett uppdrag enligt följande: 6 studenter från Akademiska sjukhuset och 1 student från Carema primärvård.

2. Övergripande kommentarer

Under året tillsvidareanställdes 2 adjunkter (1 kvinna; 1 man) varav en befordrades till lektor (kvinna), 1 koordinator (man), och 1 forskare (man). 1 lektor befordrades till professor (kvinna) och 2 professorer (kvinnor), 1 adjunkt (kvinna) gick i pension samt

1 ekonomiadministratör (kvinna) gick under året i delpension. 5 personer har varit långtidssjukskrivna på 25% eller mer under året.

3. Kommentarer kring utbildning på grund- och avancerad nivå

Fakultetsuppdraget har utförts med cirka 1,5 HST färre registreringar än vad som ålagts institutionen. Anledning till detta var att vår avsikt var att ligga så nära uppdraget som möjligt för att inte belasta kollegiet mer än nödvändigt. Några sena avhopp innan registrering fick till följd att vi inte helt uppfyllde uppdraget.

Under kalenderåret 2012 har institutionen genomfört kursvärderingar via nätet samt i pappersform. Institutionen publicerar på externa hemsidan de kursrapporter som är baserade på studenternas kursvärderingar samt på kursledarnas egen reflektion över kursen. Kursledare bör, vid varje kursstart, ge en kort redogörelse av den tidigare kursvärderingens resultat och ta upp vad som har förändrats och vad man kommer att behålla i dess tidigare form.

Institutionen erbjuder sedan hösten 2011 en termin av kurser i psykologi som ges på engelska på grundläggande nivå. De kurser på engelska på avancerad nivå som ges inom psykologprogrammet kan även utbytesstudenter läsa om dessa studenter uppfyller behörighetskraven. Detta gör att ämnet psykologi blir mer tillgängligt för utbytesstudenter som kommer till Uppsala universitet.

4. Kommentarer kring forskning och forskarutbildning

Institutionens forskning täcker många av psykologins huvudområden, som emotions-psykologi, klinisk psykologi, kognitionspsykologi, neuropsykologi, personlighets- och socialpsykologi och utvecklingspsykologi. Rekryteringen av en lärostolsprofessor efter en professor som gick i pension under februari 2012 (Gunilla Bohlin) inleddes redan under 2011 och i ljuset av de synpunkter som framkom i KoF11 om behovet av en ökad strategisk styrning för att försäkra sig om att forskningen på institutionen har en rimlig bredd betonades särskilt behovet av att komplettera institutionens forskningsprofil på eftersatta områden i denna utlysning. Därför fattades, under året, beslut om anställning av en ny lärostolsprofessor i psykologi ssk socialpsykologi (Torun Lindholm) med tillträde i januari 2013. I övrigt karaktäriserades 2012 av stor forskningsproduktivitet i tidskrifter av hög internationell klass och med stort genomslag, bl. a Science. Institutionen har ett omfattande inflöde av externa anslag och en mycket expanderande forskningsverksamhet – i synnerhet i anslutning till det s.k. Barn och babylabbet. Institutionens doktorander är mycket aktiva och av central betydelse för den forskning som produceras.

Under 2012 gavs fem kurser på forskarnivå. Under vårterminen gavs en kurs i Bayesiansk data analys (7.5 hp) och en kurs i MATLAB. På höstterminen gavs kurserna Kognitionspsykologi (7.5 hp), Allmän forskningsmetodik – Design och analys 15 hp och Allmän forskningsmetodik – Psykologiska mätmetoder med mätteori 7.5 hp.

5. Kommentarer kring uppdragsutbildningen

Uppdragsutbildningar har inte förändrades på något radikalt sätt under 2012. Vi upplever oss även ha ett gott samarbete med de aktörer som köper dessa utbildningar.

10. Samverkan med det omgivande samhället

De internationella kontakterna och utbytena är mycket stort för många av institutionens forskargrupper som bl.a. avspeglas i redogörelsen under punkt 9. De inhemska samarbetena är av vitalt omfång inklusive de fakultetsöverskridande samarbetena inom Uppsala universitet framförallt med Medicinska fakulteten. Institutionen höll ett stort antal s.k. Öppna seminarium bl.a. i musikpsykologi under året och medverkade även vid Psykologidagen – ett studentdrivet evenemang

Många av våra medarbetare deltar flitigt i olika massmediala sammanhang – både lärare och forskare.
